An ordinance amending the future land use classification to fifty or fewer acres of land (small scale) on the future land use plan map of the City of Live Oak Comprehensive Plan, pursuant to an application, CPA 23-02, by the property owner(s) and/or their authorized, designated representative(s), providing for a change in the assigned future land use classification From Commercial To Residential, High Density, on certain lands within the corporate limits of the City of Live Oak, Florida (Subject Property located along the north side of Ranchera Street NW.)
