

City of Live Oak
Special Called City Council Meeting Minutes
October 28, 2024

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The Live Oak City Council met Tuesday, October 28, 2024, at 5:30 p.m. in City Hall located at 101 SE White Ave., Live Oak, Florida 32064 for a Special Called City Council Meeting. The following officials were present: Mayor Frank Davis, Council President Matt Campbell, Councilmember Vanessa Robinson, Councilmember David Alford, City Attorney Todd Kennon, City Manager Larry Sessions, and City Clerk John Gill. Absent: Councilmember Tommie Jefferson, Councilmember Gladys Owens.

Council President Campbell called the meeting to order.

Mayor Frank Davis led the Invocation followed by Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Council President Campbell proceeded to the approval of the agenda, with any additions, deletions, or changes. Councilmember Alford made a motion to approve the agenda as presented, which Councilmember Robinson seconded. With no discussion the motion carried unanimously.

Council President Campbell then opened the floor for public comments. With none heard, the floor was closed for public comments.

Council President Campbell moved to discussion with possible council action on Resolution 2024-35, a resolution authorizing the execution of a contract with Purvis Gray and Company LLP, to provide auditing services for the fiscal years ending September 30, 2024, September 30, 2025, and September 30, 2026. City Attorney Kennon read the title into the record. Councilmember Alford made a motion to approve Resolution 2024-35, which Councilmember Robinson seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Council President Campbell proceeded to discussion with possible council action, Resolution 2024-3036, a resolution accepting a bid from Worth Construction & Development Inc. related to the portable water line improvements within the City of Live Oak Florida providing for the award and execution of a contract. Mr. Kennon read the title into the record. Councilmember Robinson made a motion to approve Resolution 2024-36, which Councilmember Alford seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

With there being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
